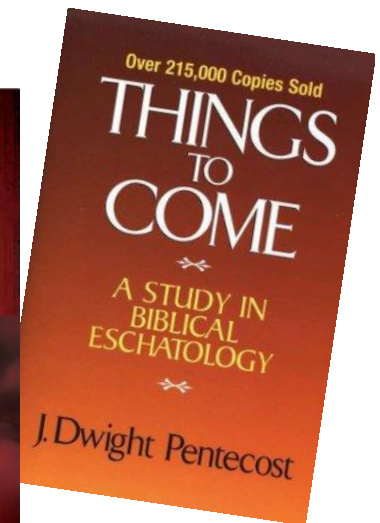
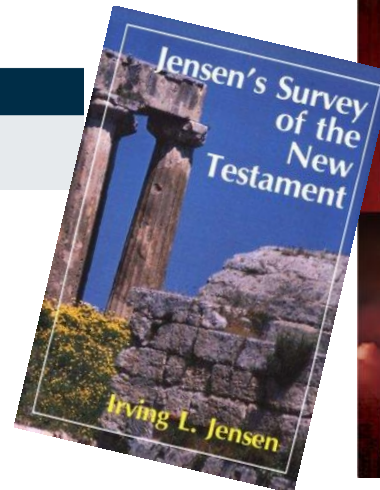

Purpose of Studying...

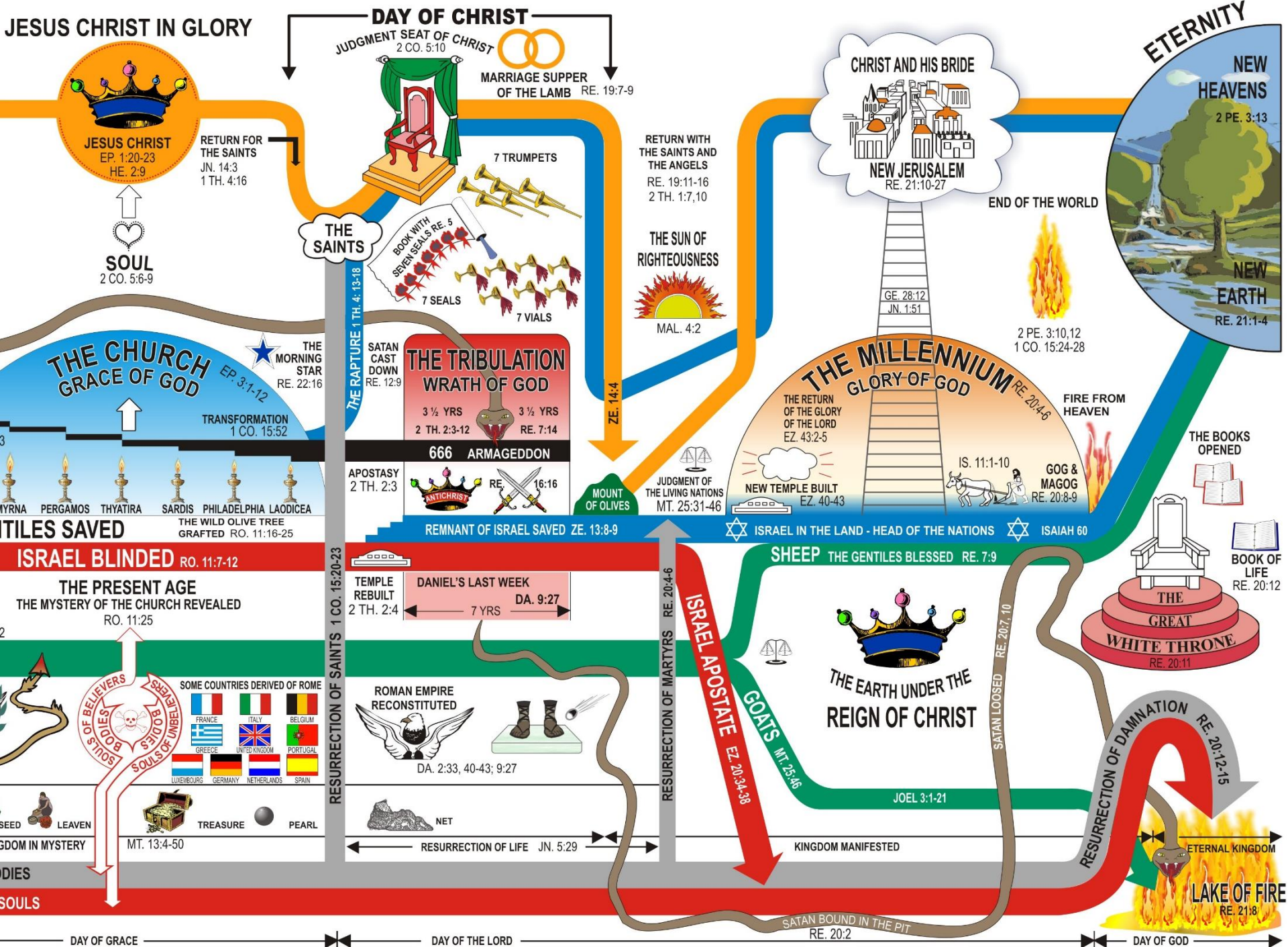
- Rev. 1.3: Blessed is he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand
- 'Revelation' = unveiling, taking off the lid
- Revelation **of** Jesus Christ (Rev. 1.1)
- Completes the circle of divine truth

- **Literally:** If the plain sense makes good sense, seek no other sense lest it become nonsense
- **Symbols**
- **Interpretation:** Preterist; Futurist; Historicist; Idealist
- **Millennium:** Pre-millennial; Amillennial; Post-millennial
- **Rapture:** Pre-trib; Mid-trib; Post-trib
