
Purpose of Studying...


- o **Rev. 1.3**: Blessed is he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand
- o 'Revelation' = unveiling, taking off the lid
- o Revelation of Jesus Christ (Rev. 1.1)
- o Completes the circle of divine truth

Principles in Studying...



- o **Literally**: If the plain sense makes good sense, seek no other sense lest it become nonsense
- Symbols
- o Interpretation: Preterist; <u>Futurist</u>; Historicist; Idealist
- o Millennium: <u>Pre-millennial</u>; Amillennial; Post-millennial
- o Rapture: Pre-trib; Mid-trib; Post-trib
