THEY PREACHED THE WORD

ACTS 13.35: "WHEREFORE HE SAITH ALSO IN ANOTHER PSALM, THOU SHALT NOT SUFFER THINE HOLY ONE TO SEE CORRUPTION."

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THEY EMPHASISED GOD

ACTS 13.30: "BUT GOD RAISED HIM FROM THE DEAD."

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THEY FOCUSSED ON CHRIST

ACTS 13.29: "AND WHEN THEY HAD FULFILLED ALL THAT WAS WRITTEN OF HIM, THEY TOOK HIM DOWN FROM THE TREE, AND LAID HIM IN A SEPULCHRE."

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THEY APPEALED TO FAITH

ACTS 13.39: "AND BY HIM ALL THAT BELIEVE ARE JUSTIFIED FROM ALL THINGS, FROM WHICH YE COULD NOT BE JUSTIFIED BY THE LAW OF MOSES."

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THEY REWAINED STEADFAST

THEY WERE NOT SATISFIED WITH SUCCESS OR DEFEATED BY DISAPPOINTMENT.
